

Forklift Grapples

Forklift Grapple - Grapples work in conjunction with the crowning operation of the bucket cylinder located on the excavator. They could mount directly onto the jib or whichever quick hitch which is in bucket position. Grapples are most often meant for the processing and handling of construction materials, timber, domestic and aggregate waste items. The grapple's boxed design has additional support bridging. This manufactured design provides the grapple with maximum strength and support by preventing the body from breaking and twisting all through its operation.

The grapple as well as all of its moving parts are made out of hardened steel. The revolving points are designed in order to guarantee supreme closing force and holding ability. The one operating it has the capacity to handle all sizes and varieties of materials using the jaws fitted at the end of the grapple with toes. This enables the jaws to be able to close through one another in a finger configuration for utmost handling capacity.
