Pulp Clamps - There are many other lift truck attachments that can be used in order to make lift trucks much more effective. Snowplow accessories can be mounted onto the front part of a forklift. A scoop bucket can be useful whenever the job requires transferring soil, sand, snow, or gravel. A double block handler allows the person operating the forklift to pick up 2 loads and after that stack them beside each other. Numerous of those accessories are considered ideal for light to medium duty work.

One of the lift truck attachments, called a package lift clamp, allows for the transferring and carrying of very heavy pallets. Pallet crane forks are likewise used in order to move and carry pallets by using an overhead crane. A drum clamp accessory is useful for moving heavy drums from one place to another without having to make use of a pallet. Forklift mounted hoppers allow materials to be moved and dumped without having to handle it by hand. These hoppers when the bumper is released are self dumping.

Obtainable accessories now consist of accessories that allow a lift truck to carry out the job of a commercial mop or broom. These particular accessories are often used cleaning parking areas, warehouse flooring, and boat docks. Lift truck mounted platforms come equipped with dual entry doors and can be attached in order to move workers from one site to another. The mounted platform accessory is ideal for reaching parts which could be difficult to access, specifically if you have products or supplies stored in out of the way locations or way up high.

Attachments can be a very useful piece of equipment when put in a forklift, changing an typical forklift right into a mobile hoist unit. It's most helpful when moving unbalanced or difficult loads. This attachment can either be telescopic, mounted on the carriage itself, or be attached or lift truck mounted.
