Compared to the quick-tach container models, universal fit buckets are fifty percent. This extra room makes them ideal for carrying irregular shaped loads like backfilling behind walls, tearing off roof trash, elevating roof gravel, moving large debris piles and broken up concrete.

The Quick-Tach is able to dump materials around 1.5 feet higher due to the shorter depth of its bucket.
