Side Tilt Carriages

Side Tilt Carriage - There are 4 sizes of hook type blade carriages rated by the blade carriage lifting capability. Hook type blade carriages have been consistent.

Class I carriages are rated for cargo up to 2000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing utilized for Class I is 13 inches. Class II carriages are rated for loads up to 5,550 lbs. Their carriage bar spacing is sixteen inches. Class III carriages are rated for loads as much as 10,000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this particular class is 20 inches. Class IV carriages are rated for loads as much as 15,500 lbs. The carriage bar spacing utilized for this capacity is 25 inches.

The carriages for pin type forks may be different depending on the maker. Pin mounted tines can vary by the amount of offset between the tine eye and the fork. Carriage capacity would be established by the carriage pin size and by the tine size.
